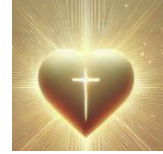
So THANK YOU, PASTOR PAUL! He can now resume his 2nd retirement.

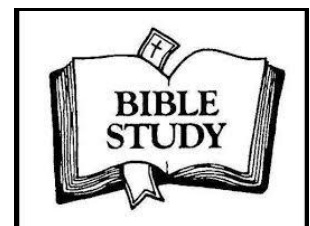
